Report from the Treasurer: Travel Bursaries 2017

- Bursaries advertised via IASCL website & conference website with published deadline for applications. A second deadline announced following initial awards.
- Criteria – presenter of a paper or poster
- Committee of IASCL President, Chair of Trustees, & Treasurer.
- 39 applications to Round one, all awarded (combination of PhD students & faculty members)
- 79 applications received to Round 2, of which 32 PhD students funded. Total **71 awards** made.
